

AUDITION WORKSHOP PROPOSAL

Part 1: Q and A Approx. 30 minutes

Description: Lead a discussion and answer questions pertaining to life as a professional actor and life on tour.

Part 2: Intro to Workshop Topic Approx. 5-10 minutes

Description: Introduce the basics of auditioning or whatever the workshop is geared towards, such as acting through song, monologues, scene study, acting on camera, etc. Detail the ideas and concepts of what makes a successful audition. Focusing on the philosophy that we use performance as a chance to showcase our best self.
